The girls team gained 6 wins, drew 1 and lost 1, scoring 43 tries over the day. In their section they came 1st overall!!!

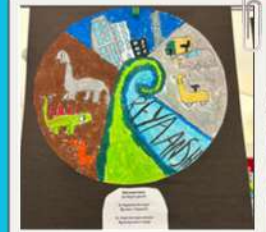
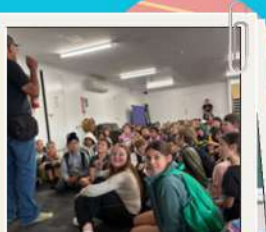
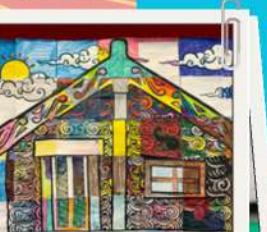
What fantastic results.
